Whether you are celebrating a special date or just getting away from home for a night, we are truly thankful that you have chosen The Nines as your hotel in Portland.

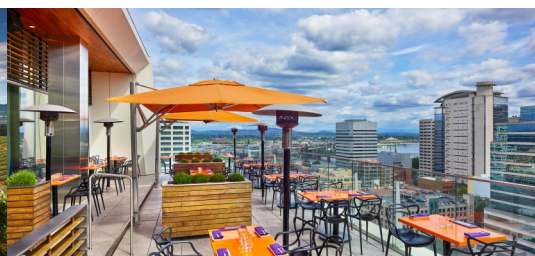

The Columbia River Gorge is the natural crown jewel of the North-west. Stretching over 80 miles, it is home to Multnomah Falls.



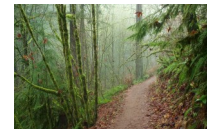
The Willamette Valley

The Willamette Valley is a 150 mile long stretch containing over 500 wineries and providing world class Pinot Noirs.



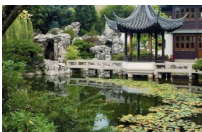
Forest Park

Home to over 10,000 rose bushes and 650 varieties, this garden is the oldest operational rose test garden in the US.



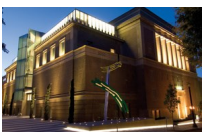
Japanese Gardens
